**Explanation of Responses:**

- Restricted stock units of ExlService Holdings, Inc. (the "Company") convert into common stock, par value \$0.001 per share (the "Common Stock") on a one-for-one basis.
- Pursuant to the ExlService Holdings, Inc. 2018 Omnibus Incentive Plan, pursuant to which such restricted stock units were granted, the closing price of the Common Stock on the Nasdaq Global Select Market on the preceding day is used for purposes of computing tax reporting and withholding.
- On February 15, 2023, the reporting person was granted 3,288 (pre-split) restricted stock units, vesting in four equal annual installments beginning on the first anniversary of the grant date. 25 percent of the restricted stock units became vested on February 15, 2024, an additional 25 percent of the restricted stock units became vested on February 15, 2025, an additional 25 percent of the restricted stock units will vest on February 15, 2026, and the remaining balance of 25 percent of the restricted stock units will vest on February 15, 2027.
- On February 16, 2022, the reporting person was granted 3,884 (pre-split) restricted stock units, vesting in four equal annual installments beginning on the first anniversary of the grant date. 25 percent of the restricted stock units became vested on February 16, 2023, an additional 25 percent of the restricted stock units became vested on February 16, 2024, an additional 25 percent of the restricted stock units became vested on February 16, 2025, and the remaining balance of 25 percent of the restricted stock units will vest on February 16, 2026.
- On February 17, 2021, the reporting person was granted 6,920 (pre-split) restricted stock units, vesting in four equal annual installments beginning on the first anniversary of the grant date. 25 percent of the restricted stock units became vested on February 17, 2022, an additional 25 percent of the restricted stock units became vested on February 17, 2023, an additional 25 percent of the restricted stock units

became vested on February 17, 2024, and the remaining balance of 25 percent of the restricted stock units became vested on February 17, 2025.
